When I have crossed the bar.



## HENRY FRANCIS RAMSAY DIES

## Funeral Services Will Be Held Here Sunday Afternoon

Henry Francis Ramsay, aged 81 years, 2 months and 28 days, died at 6:00 last night at the home of his son, Don Ramsay, Sixteenth and Madison street. He had been ill for the past five weeks and only a short time ago had been brought home from Johnson hospital in Chanute, where he received treatment.

The funeral services will be held at 3:00 Sunday afternoon at the United Brethren church, conducted by the pastor, the Rev. F. V. Smith, and burial is to be in the Fredonia cemetery, under the direction of the Cason Mortuary.

Those who mourn his passing include six sons, Clay C., Burke W., Don and Hollie of Fredonia; Ard of Bloomington, Calif., and Roe of Hollywood, Calif.; one daughter, Mrs. Darrel Thornton of Fredonia, and one brother, Wallace B. Ramsay of

Riverside, Calif.

The deceased had made Fredonia his home for many years. He went to California last fall and spent the winter months visiting relatives, returning to this city during the summer.
