Dear Best Family Member:



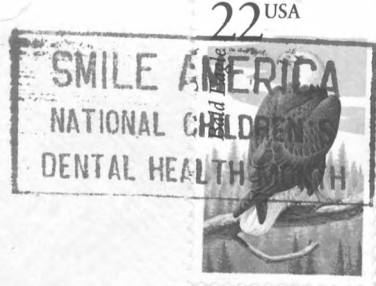

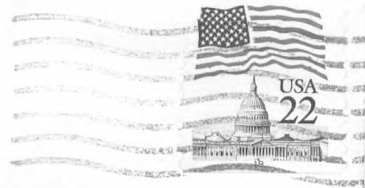

Since then I have been in touch with a Patricia Campbell, Box 3081, Togus, Maine 04330 and she is of the same family as you and I but closer to you. Her family is also Aaron and Eliza but then she descends from William Ota. She hasn't gone any further back than you or I.

I found the enclosed in a Harrison County History book but don't know if I sent it to you previously or not.

Last summer Lyle and I on vacation went north into Canada, Lake Louise, across to Victoria Island, down to Seattle (our son had gone to Seattle and up into Canada playing fastpitch softball and we met him there). Don flew on home but Lyle and I then came home via Oregon coast then back east and we spent one afternoon and a night in Salt Lake City. We spent the time in Mormon Square but hardly had time to do any research. Found out if one wanted to do research must have several days. Anyway we found what was there if had time to look it all up. I wrote down a few names of people looking for the same surnames.

and his father were Masons, and members of Lodge No. 189, A. F. & A. M. at Oregon. Mr. Van Buskirk married Charlotte V. Cummins, who was born near Shelby, Ohio. They were married October 12, 1871, and are the parents of two daughters. Caroline, the first, is now the wife of George Lehmer of Oregon. Rebecca is the wife of Frank C. Allen, also a resident of Oregon. A son of Mr. and Mrs. Van Buskirk died in infancy. The grandchildren are: Lawrence V. Lehmer and Paul V. Allen, Ruth Allen and Charlotte Allen.

AARON GRAHAM SCOTT, one of the ante-bellum settlers of Harrison County, Missouri, came hither in September, 1858, with his father, Moses Scott. He is a native of Jefferson County, Indiana, born near the City of Madison, July 18, 1850, and his father was born just across the Ohio River from Indiana, December 3, 1817, and died on his farm near Blythedale, Missouri, February 3, 1888, aged seventy years and two months.

Aaron T. Scott, the grandfather of Aaron G., was a Scotch-Irishman and a soldier during the War of 1812, and spent the greater part of his life near Madison, Jefferson County, Indiana. He died near Galesburg, Illinois. Mr. Scott's wife's maiden name was Anna Aja Scott, and they had the following children: Moses, the father of Aaron G.; Elizabeth, who married Oliver Graham; Sarah, who married Colonel Amix; Jerome; Benjamin F., who went through the Civil war for four years as a soldier and died in Oklahoma; Harriet, who was one of the older children and married Lewis Traupel, and Rachel, the youngest daughter, who lives at Hoyt, Kansas, and is the widow of William Robb.

Moses Scott spent his boyhood in Jefferson County, Indiana, and there was educated sparingly, so that he was able to do little more than to read and write. He was a brickmaker by trade and made the brick from which was built the first college at Hanover, Indiana, and worked at that and farming both in his native state and Missouri. Finally, however, in the latter state, he abandoned his trade that he might give his entire attention to the pursuits of the soil. His settlement was a mile southwest of Blythedale, and that farm he improved and made his final home, most of this property now being owned by William J. Brinigar. His old brick kiln was on Big Creek, west of Eagleville, on the William place. Moses Scott came to Missouri in company with several families from Knox County, Illinois, where he had spent some three years as a farmer. His outfit for the transportation of the family and effects comprised an ox-team and a yoke of cows, and the journey occupied from June to September. Among the families forming the caravan were those of James Graham, his father-in-law; Oliver Graham, and family; and John R. and William Graham, the latter of whom lives at Ridgeway, Missouri. All of these settled in the same neighborhood and their posterity is numbered among the citizenship here now. Moses Scott's participation in politics was as a democrat, but he never held public office. He was a Baptist of the Missionary faith who lived up to the teachings of his church, was known to be strictly reliable in his dealings, paid his way as he went, and never allowed himself to go into debt. The period of the Civil war did not materially affect him save as his son, Elzumer, entered the Twenty-third Regiment, Missouri Volunteer Infantry, Company D, and went with General Sherman to the sea. Moses Scott married Mary A. Graham, daughter of James and Jemimah (Talbert) Graham, and of English descent on her mother's side. Mr. Graham was a native of Bardstown, Bullitt County, Kentucky, and moved first to Indiana and then to Knox County, Illinois. He was a carpenter by trade and his home in Harrison County was $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Blythedale. He died at about seventy years of age, about 1872, and his wife passed away

a few years later, and both were buried at Eagleville. Their children were as follows: Arthur, a Mexican war soldier who died at Eagleville, Missouri; Elizabeth, who married Joseph Horn and died in Texas; John R., who was a teacher and died in Mercer County, Missouri; Calvin, who was a teacher and died in Harrison County, Missouri; Sarah, who married Harry Barnes and died in Southern Illinois; Mary A., who became the wife of Mr. Scott; and William, of Ridgeway, Missouri, the youngest, who became a Union soldier during the Civil war.

The children born to Moses and Mary A. (Graham) Scott were as follows: Elzumer, who as before stated was a soldier during the Civil war, and afterwards engaged in farming in Harrison County, Missouri; Aaron Graham, of this review; Sarah J., who married Frank Loy, of Ridgeway, Missouri; Oliver, a resident of that place; Alzira, who married John A. Jones, and died in Mitchell County, Kansas; Mary, who married William Brinigar, a farmer and well-known breeder of blooded stock, near Blythedale; and Carrie, who became the wife of Porter Reeves, and now resides at Cainsville, Missouri.

Aaron Graham Scott was a child when brought to the vicinity in which he now makes his home and here he secured a somewhat limited education in the district schools. Starting out as a farmer just before reaching his majority, he worked for a time as a hand at a salary of \$15 per month, his employer being Mr. Bandy, whose daughter he married after several years. He first rented a small property known as the Guist Farm for several years, located near Eagleville, and later rented the Lundy place, on which he spent a short time. Next he purchased 100 acres of raw land, now the Loveless place, and this he improved and exchanged for his present farm in section 14, township 65, range 27. This was a settled place and he succeeded William Kincaid here in 1888. He owns 260 acres and has been engaged in stock and grain farming. Recently he has embarked in the Short Horn and Poland-China hog breeding, his Short Horn cattle coming from the Kansas Bellows herd and his first exhibit for prizes being made in the fall of 1914. In politics Mr. Scott is a republican, and for two years was assessor of Marion Township.

Mr. Scott was married the first time, August 24, 1871, to Miss Ann Eliza Bandy, a daughter of Pascal and Lovica Bandy, who came to Missouri from Knox County, Illinois, and here were farmers. Mrs. Scott died August 22, 1897, leaving the following children: Elzumer, cashier of the Commercial Bank of Ridgeway and one of its organizers, married Carrie Sallee, and has three children, Kenneth, Winogene and Roland; Charles, traffic manager for the Pioneer Coöperage Company, of Chicago, Illinois, married Annie Hughey, and has four children, Beulah, Aaron Graham, Jr., Geraldine and Annie Hughey; W. Ota, of Towner, Colorado, married Mary Morris, and has three children, Ronald, Morris and Estalene; Oscar, a farmer of this county, married Myrtle Israel, and has three children, Vera, Truman and Lucile; Minnie, the wife of Ruthy Jacobs, of St. Anthony, Idaho, has four children, Olin, Evelyn, Hazel and Charline; Zene, associated with the Interstate Commerce Commission, at Washington, D. C., married and has a child, Mildred; Edna and Eva, twins, the former unmarried and a resident of Indianapolis, Indiana, while the latter is the wife of Ernest Grubb, of Maryville, Missouri, and has two children, Roberta and Marion; Ruth, who is the wife of Kenneth Weary, of Cainsville, Missouri, and has no children; Mary, who is the wife of T. W. McKinnon, who is associated with the United States Government service at Washington, D. C.; and Ralph, who is the youngest of the children.

Mr. Scott was married a second time September 7, 1898, to Miss Eva

Alice Eyerly, daughter of George W. Eyerly and Martha A. (Howell) Eyerly. Mr. Eyerly came to Missouri from Ohio, but now resides at Winterset, Iowa, while his wife is deceased. He is a veteran of the Civil war, and has passed his life in the pursuits of farming. Of his thirteen children, eleven have grown to maturity, but only two, Mrs. Scott and Mrs. Louella Cocklin, reside in Missouri. Five children have been born to Mr. and Mrs. Scott: Howard, Russell, Raymond, Fern and Ione. Mr. Scott is the father of sixteen children, all living, and is the grandfather of twenty.

FRED HARTLEY. For thirty-eight years Fred Hartley has been identified with the monument business, and for twelve of these has been in business for himself at Savannah, Missouri, where he is one of the representative and enterprising men in other lines and is numbered with the most useful citizens of the county seat of Andrew County. He was born in Putnam County, Indiana, May 31, 1861, and is a son of Rufus and Jennie (Beard) Hartley. Both parents were natives of Indiana and resided there until 1865 when they moved to Ringgold County, Iowa, and from there in 1872, to Worth County, Missouri, settling permanently in Andrew County, Missouri, in 1877. The father was engaged in the monument business at Savannah during the rest of his active life. His death occurred in 1907, at the age of seventy-seven years. The mother survives and lives at Savannah. They had five children: John, who is a resident of New Mexico; Charles, who is in business at St. Joseph, Missouri; Fred; Samuel, who is associated with his brother Fred at Savannah; and Minnie, for the past fifteen years a teacher in the public schools at Savannah, who is now the wife of Samuel Cline.

Fred Hartley obtained his education in the public schools and began to learn marble cutting in his father's shop in boyhood and later mastered every detail of the business. For twelve years he was superintendent for the Des Moines Marble and Mantel Company, a large concern doing business in several states, but for twelve years he has conducted his own monument works at Savannah, which city he has claimed as his home since 1877. He has large yards and employs skilled workmen, conducting his business according to his ideas of a business man's responsibility. His public spirit was manifested in the establishing here of the Globe Theater, a moving picture house and the first of its class in the place. The building was opened April 20, 1914, and he operates it himself. It is proving a very successful venture. In politics Mr. Hartley is a republican and is serving as one of the city's aldermen and is credited with looking after the interests of his own ward with the same care that he gives to his private affairs.

In 1888 Mr. Hartley was united in marriage with Miss Anna M. Smith, who is a daughter of Henry M. and Katherine Smith. Mrs. Hartley was born in Pennsylvania but was reared in Andrew County, Missouri. Mr. and Mrs. Hartley have one son, Harry S., who is a very talented young man and is a graduate of the class of 1913, of the Art Institute, Chicago. At present he is a popular cartoonist, working under Cartoonist Darling, on the Register and Leader, of Des Moines, Iowa. Mr. Hartley belongs to the Modern Woodmen of America and to the Knights of Pythias.


Dear Mrs. Scott:

I have learned of your interest in the family of Pierre Salle through the Family Registry Index in the Genealogy Library of the Winston-Salem branch of the Morman Church.

I will attempt to describe my research as related to the Salle/Salley family. I am the daughter of Richard Bryan Salley. I have traced his family through census records of Person and Stokes Counties in North Carolina back to my great-great grandfather, Joseph Salley, who was living in Person County in 1850.

I have been unable to identify the father of Joseph Salley. I feel that it is very likely to have been William Salle, son of Joseph Salle, Sr., or one of his brothers. I have found listed in the same source ("Marriage Bonds of Powhatan County, Va.") the following:

William Salle m. Frances Carter	15 Oct. 1796
George Salle m. Ann Carter	25 Dec. 1800
John Salle m. Susannah Goode	13 June 1803
Joseph Salle m. Judith Pankey	19 Nov. 1795

I do not have proof that the William Salle (above) is the son of Joseph Salle, Sr., (who removed to Kentucky), but it would appear the above bonds were from his family. Children are listed in will probated in Jessamine County, Kentucky.

I have been able to document the family of Abraham Salle through Joseph Salle, Sr., but cannot find proof of a tie-in to my Joseph Salley of Person County. I am enclosing a brief outline of my research. You will note the similarity of names. I am hoping you will be able to clarify the missing link.

There are others in this area (such as John Peter Salling/Salley) of Augusta County, Virginia, who, I feel, must fit into the puzzle. I look forward to hearing your comments.



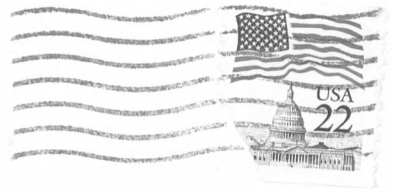

I understand that you have researched the Sallee family history. I located your name in the files at the genealogical library at the local stake of the Latter Day Saints Church, here in Pensacola. I understand that you are a descendant of Pierre Sallee. I am trying to trace the Sallee line in Kentucky, but I can go no further back than my great-grandfather, Frank Sallee, who was born in Kentucky around 1840.

He married Rachel Jane Diler, and they had 8 children, two daughters and six sons, most of whom died young. Their names were Grant, Alford (Alfred), Thomas, Everette, Buck, and Joe, my paternal grandfather. I have always heard that that both of the daughters died young, and I don't have their names.

In a book on land grants, in the early days of Kentucky, in 1792, John Salley received 400 acres and Phillip Salley and William Sally received 384 acres each on Cox Creek in Jefferson County in 1792. The surveyors were Mark, Conrad & John Dyer. These names had not shown up anywhere else in my research, and I have not yet been able to locate them in a census of that era, but I intend to keep working that aspect.

Do you think that it might be possible that some of o Pierre's lineage may have settled in Kentucky in the mid 1800's? I would be most interested in any information you might have on any Sallees who might have migrated there, or if you might be able to refer me to someone who might be working this line.

In the Family Registry of the Mormon Geneological Library, you are listed as desiring to exchange information on a George Bandy who married Druciller Meador circa 1778. My wife was a Bandy and for a number of years we have been accumulating bits and pieces of her direct line as well as other branches. We have come across two conflicting interpretations of the Bandy family relationships in the 18th and early 19th centuries. An attachment lists both of these briefly. So far, we have not been able to substantiate either.

Arlene (Mrs. Wayne E.) Cook of Villa Park, IL, did some work in 1981 of which I show a small portion on the attachment calling it "The Cook Interpretation". In 1959, Mabel Ruth Bandy (Mrs. Frederick) Anheuser of Kimmswick, Missouri, had come to conclusions similar to Mrs. Cook's. In 1954-55, Mrs. Edythe Rucker Whitley, of Nashville, TN, came to the conclusions I have abbreviated in the attachment and called "The Whitley Conclusion".

I have copies of all three of these people's Bandy files. None indicate where the data for their differing conclusions come from. Curiously, both Anheuser and Whitley cite private correspondence with a Mr. Ballard from Newton, NC, as a source for their (different) early conclusions.

I wrote Mrs. Cook, Mrs. Anheuser, and Mrs. Whitley about 18 months ago. The first two did not respond. Mrs. Whitley referred me to the Williamson County, TN, library who now have her papers. I went there but did not find anything more than that which I already had copies of. I also wrote the Claremont, NC, Library inquiring about Mr. Ballard. They do not know of any of his papers which still exist. They did give me the name of a granddaughter of Mr. Ballard, Mrs. David S. (Margaret) Clark, 319 S. Main Ave., Newton, NC, 28658, but I have not contacted her.

As I said above, I have a copy of all of Mrs. Whitley's Bandy file, and an unknown portion of both Mrs. Cook's and Mrs. Anheuser's. If you would like all or specific information from any of these, please let me know. Our own interest is more in the line (ancestry and descendents) of Thomas (1748-1835) who Mrs. Cook says is a brother of your George. We would appreciate any information in this area as well as any which clarifies the "Cook-Whitley" differences.

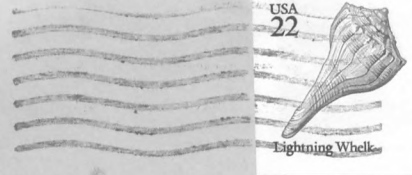

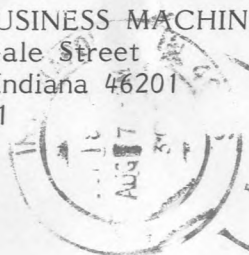

The Graves-Miller data is in my computer for families and past generations covering one hundred eighty-five generations, [185] going back to the days of Adam and

I have direct line relationships of father-mother to children descendency including children with spouses of the father-mother. However, I do not include children of the children, except for direct line to the succeeding ancestor of Charles Graves and his descendents.

The data encompasses over six thousand one hundred [6,100] direct line ancestors and over eleven thousand [11,000] ancestors with children and spouses.

I can print out an alphabetical index of the 11,000 names indicating direct line ancestors, consisting of about 300 pages at my cost of \$35.00 which includes shipping to anywhere in the United States. Since I am retired, my time is not included, as the cost is my only concern at the present time.

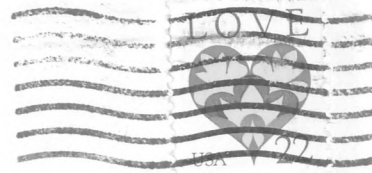
One method of printing out data is to use the family sheet, which includes the parents and their children with spouses. Data includes birth, place of birth, marriage and location, death and burial, if known or shown in the records. These sheets could be run for about 25 cents each plus postage up to 100 pages and then reducing in cost down to 15 cents per page.

To print out all of the pedigree charts for direct line ancestors would encompass approximately 4,000 pages, whereas to print out all of the family charts would encompass approximately 6,500 pages.

The above cost is subject to change, should I be required to employ assistance in getting the data out, if the request is too large for myself to handle directly. If such should be the case, then anyone so requesting would be notified prior to printing out any data.

I got your name from the family register at the LDS branch library in Springfield, Mo. I am also researching the Hilliards. My grandmother was Lettie Louise Hilliard born 17 Jul 1893, Drew Co., Ark., daughter of Richard Clark Woodward Hilliard, born Sept 1856, Fairfield Co., S.C. and Agacees Nancy Miller, born 7 Oct 1866, Drew Co., Ark. R.C.W. Hilliard's parents were Armistead Dandridge Hilliard, born 1820, Fairfield Co., S.C. and Suvilla Pearson Woodward, born 1835, Fairfield Co., S.C. A.D. Hilliard's parents were, Armistead Dandridge Hilliard, born 1794, S.C. and N. (?), born 1794, S.C.

When my Woodwards and Hilliards left S.C. at the outbreak of the Civil War, they traveled through Atlanta, Ga., and Mobile, Alabama. Then to New Orleans and then to Shreveport, La., and settled in a little town called Rocky Mount, La., and later moved on to Rock Springs, Ark. (I guess this is one of these towns that is no more, because I can't find it on todays maps)

According to a journal that was passed on to me, the Hilliard s scattered to who-knows-where, but Armistead Jr. apparently died in another town I can't find called Brownsville, Ga. while visiting other Hilliards there. So some of them must have stayed in Ga. in their travels to La., or decided to go back after the war. I'm beginning to believe they (the Hilliards) all had wonderlust, because I'm having a terrible time finding them. Also according to the journal, the Hilliards were "Holland Dutch by way of England".

I sure hope we can help each other out on these Hilliards. I will be happy to exchange group sheets and any other material that I might have that will be of help. (which isn't much on my part, I'm afraid). I hope to hear from you real soon.

I obtained your name through the LDS Family Registry quite a while ago but now I can't seem to recall if I ever wrote to you or not. If so, please excuse the repetition.

I am also researching Anthony Annable (1599-1674). I'm a descendant by his dau. Desire (1653-1706) from either his 2nd or 3rd mar. There seems to be a discrepancy in records.

Desire married John Barker and in all of my Barker genealogy it refers to her as the dau. of Anthony Annable & Anne Clark.

However, according to "Journals New England Marriages prior to 1700" it lists the following marriages for Anthony Annable:

- (1) m. 26 Apr. 1619 to Jane Mumford (d. 1643)
- (2) m. 01 Mar. 1645 to Anne Clark (d. 1651)
- (3) no date - 1st child b. 1653 to Ann ^{or Hannah} Barker (d. 1658)

According to "The Annable Family in America 1623-1967" by Anthony Annable 9th gen: it list Anne Clark as the mother of Desire - no mention of a 3rd marriage. "The Magazine of American Genealogy" under Immigrants to America Before 1750 agrees with that info. but it goes on to add that "Ancient Landmarks of Plymouth" by Davis named an Anthony, Jr. as youngest child and attributes last three children to him - which would be my Desire.

The more I read, the more confused I seem to get! Had you heard anything of a Jr.? Another discrepancy seems to be when he actually came to America for the first

" Aaron T. Scott (Grandfather of Aaron Graham Scott) was a Scotch-Irish man and a soldier during the war of 1812, and spent the greater part of his life near Madison, Jefferson County, Ind. He died near Galesburg, Ill. Aaron T. Scott's wife's maiden name was Anna Aja Scott and they had the following children:

Moses, (father of Aaron Graham Scott).

Elizabeth, who married Oliver Graham.

Sarah, who married Colonel Amix.

Jerome.

Benjamin F., who went through the civil war for four years as a soldier, and died in Oklahoma.

Harriet, who was one of the older children and married Lewis Traupel.

Rachel, the youngest daughter, who lives at Hoyt, Kans., and is the widow of William Robb."

" Moses S. Scott. Born Dec. 3, 1817. Spent boyhood in Jefferson County, Ind. and there educated sparingly, so that he was able to do little more than read and write. A bricklayer by trade and made the brick from which was built the first college at Hanover, Ind. and worked at that and farming both in his native state of Missouri. Finally, however, in the latter state he abandoned his trade that he might give his entire time and attention to the pursuits of the soil.

His settlement was a mile southwest of Blythedale, Mo., and the farm he improved and made his final home. Most of this property is now being owned by Wm. J. Brinigar. His old brick kiln was on Big Creek west of Eagleville, on the Williams place.

Moses Scott came to Mo. in the company with several families from Knox County, Ill., where he had spent some three years as a farmer. His outfit for the transportation of the family and effects included an ox team and a yoke of cows, and the journey took from June to September. Among the families forming the caravan were James Graham (his father-in-law), Oliver Graham and family; John R. and William Graham, the latter of whom lives at Ridgeway, Mo. All settled in the same neighborhood, and their posterity is numbered in the citizenship here now.

Moses Scott's participation in politics was as a Democrat, but he never held public office. He was a Baptist of the missionary faith, who lived up to the teachings of his church; was known to be strictly reliable in his dealings; paid his way as he went, and never allowed himself to go into debt. The period of the civil war did not materially affect him, except his son Elzumer entered the 23rd Reg., Mo. Volunteers, Inf. Co. D., and went with General Sherman to the sea.

" Moses Scott married Mary A. Graham, "the daughter of James and Jemimah (Albert) Graham, and of English descent on her mother's side.

The children born to Moses S. and Mary A. (Graham) Scott were:

^ Aaron Graham Scott: One of the ante bellum settlers in Harrison
County, Mo., came hither in September, 1858, with his father Moses Scott.
He was born in Jefferson County, Ind., near the town of Madison, on
July 18, 1850. (His father Moses Scott was born just across the Ohio
River from Indiana, Dec. 3, 1817, and died on his farm near Blythedale,
Mo., Feb. 3, 1888, aged 70 years and two months).

Aaron Graham was a boy of 8 when he came to Harrison County, Mo.,
where he now makes his home. He secured a somewhat limited education
in the country schools (but well grounded "in the 3 Rs"). Starting out
as a farmer, just before reaching his majority he worked for a time
as a farm hand at \$15 per month; his employer being Pascal Bandy,
whose daughter he married on Aug. 24, 1871. He first rented a small
property known as the Guist Farm, located near Eagleville, and later
rented the Lundy place, on which he spent a short time. Next he
purchased 100 acres of raw land; now the Lovelace place; and this he
improved and exchanged for his present farm in Sec. 14, Township 65,
Range 27. This was a settled place and he succeeded Wm. Kincade here
in 1888. He owns 260 acres, and has been engaged in stock and grain
raising. Recently he embarked in short-horn cattle and Poland China
hog breeding. His short horns came from the Kansas Bellows herd; his
first exhibit for prizes being made in the fall of 1914. In politics
Mr. Scott is a Republican and for two years was assessor for
Marion Township.

Aaron Graham Scott was married (1st) Aug. 24, 1871, to Ann
Eliza Bandy (daughter of Pascal and Levisa (Holland) Bandy, who
came to Mo. from Knox County, Ill. and here were farmers). Mrs. Scott
