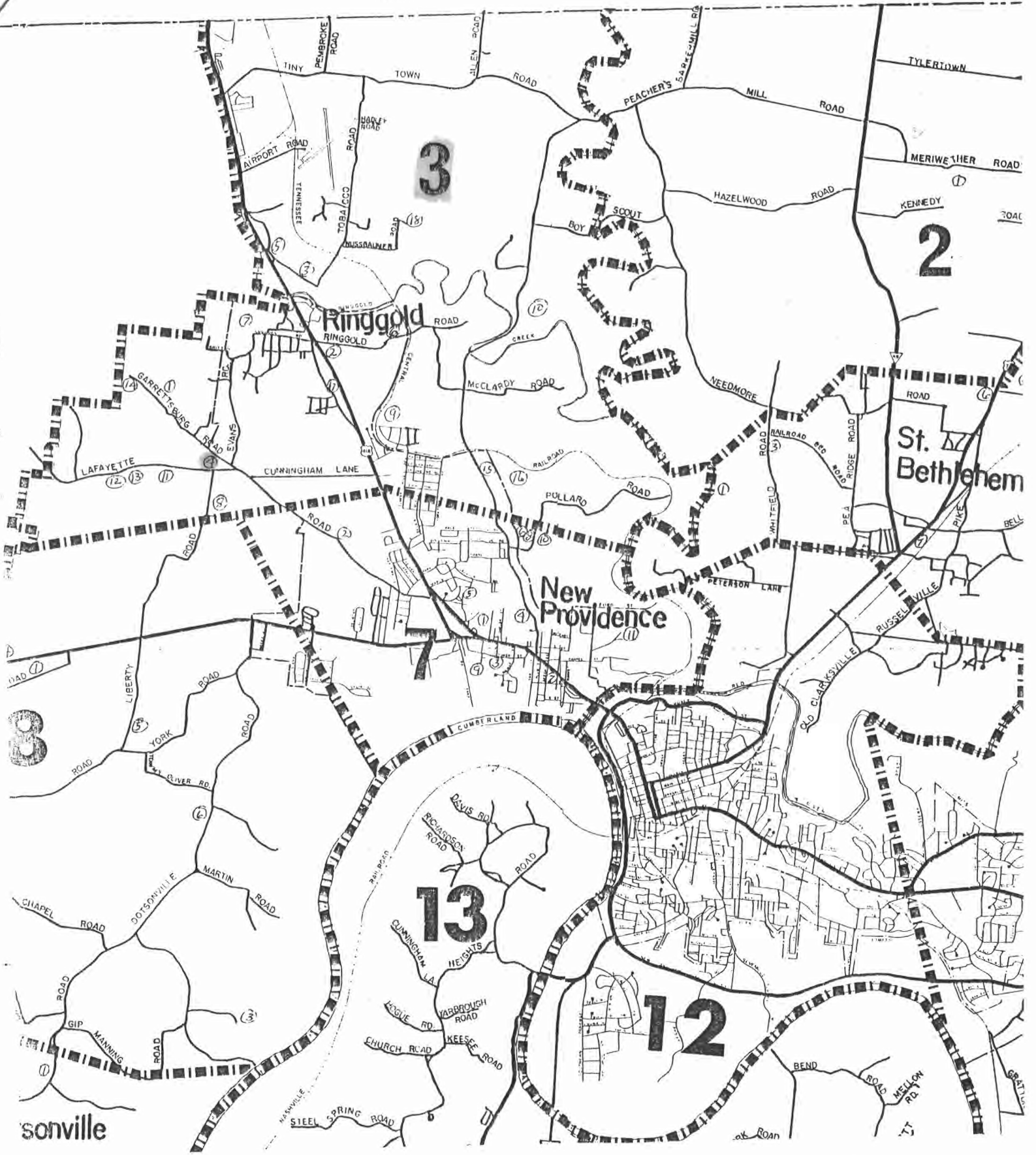

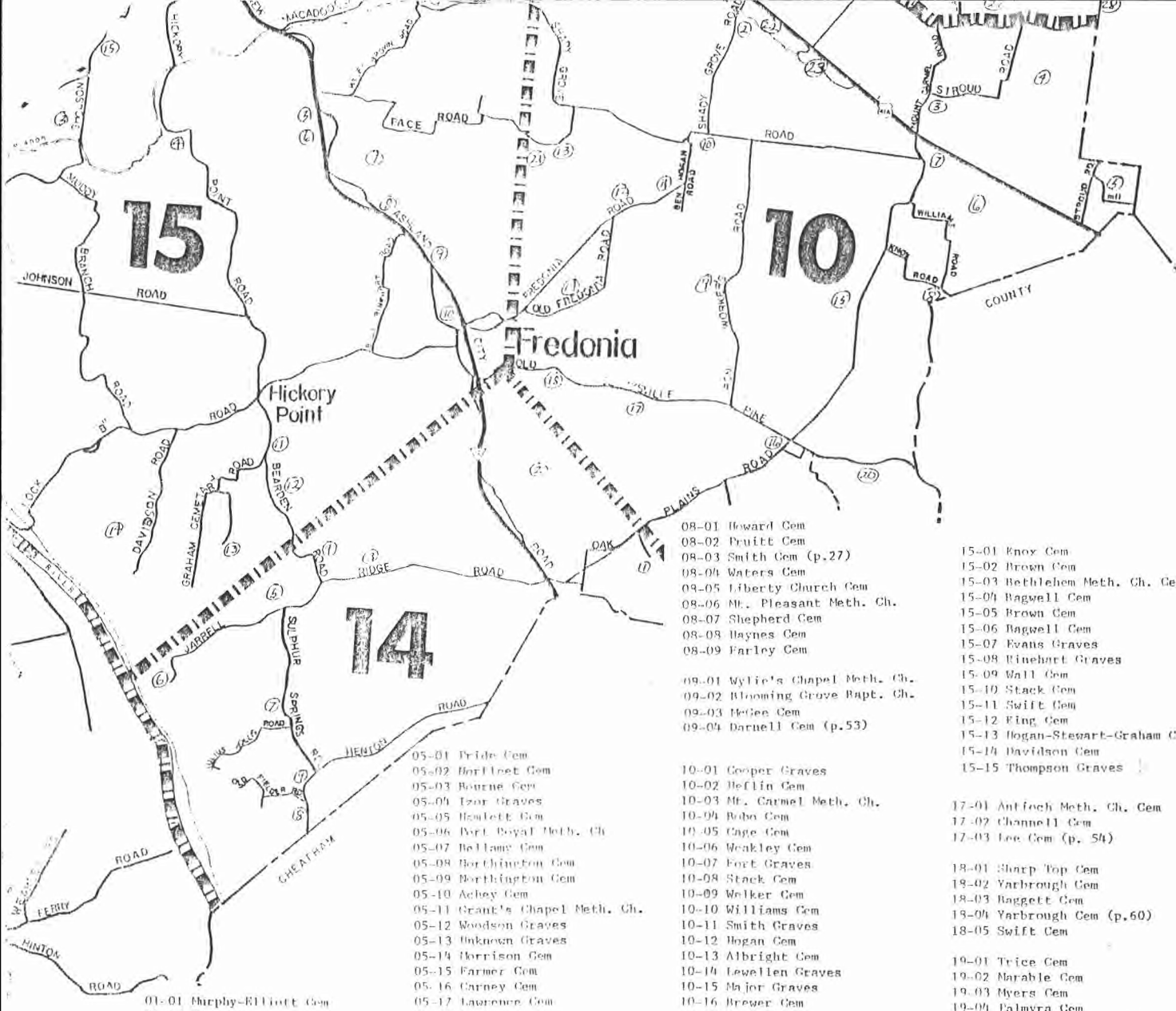

Your line did 'make the book'. Should you encounter any Sallee information which you cannot identify, let us know and maybe we can solve the mystery for you.

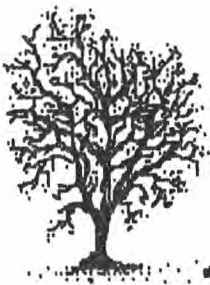

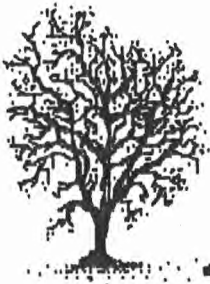

JOSEPH M. SALLEE.

After a brief illness, save that likely to attend one who had passed the full limit of the Psalmist's (four score years,) brother Joseph M. Sallee quietly fell asleep at his home near Mt. Moriah on Saturday Feb. 20, 1897 at 2:00 a. m.

Brother Sallee was born Feb. 13, 1815, in Buckingham county, Va. When about 8 years of age he went with his parents to Montgomery county, Tenn., where he was married, in 1837 to Miss Matilda Ann Dunkeson. The next year he and wife came to Missouri and settled near Spring Hill in Livingston county and from there to Mercer county five miles north-east of Cainsville, where he continued to reside until 1877, when he sold his old homestead and bought the farm adjoining Mt. Moriah in Harrison county where he has lived for twenty years.

Brother Sallee was twice married. To the first union 9 children were born, 5 of whom are now living to-wit: James H., Thos. E., Allen M., John M. and Robert, the latter is in California. The others being so generally and widely known in Harrison and Mercer counties need no introduction.

In 1854 his first wife died, and with his motherless children looking him in the face, he was on the verge of returning to Tennessee, but the wise and brotherly counsel of the late Dr. Clemmings caused him to remain.

In Sept. 1855, he was married to Miss J. J. Thompson who has been his faithful helpmate for more than 41 years and who still survives him.

To this union were born 9 children, 6 of whom are living and were present at the funeral. All the first children were also present, except Thomas E., who lives in Chillicothe and was sick, and Robert who is on the Pacific coast.

In Feb. 1861, brother Sallee and son, Thomas E., publicly professed faith in Christ, united with the Cainsville Baptist church and were baptised by Eld. John Woodward on the first Sunday in

On the removal of
Chambers to Mt. Moriah in 1862, (and who had been Clerk of the Church for 17 years,) Bro. Sallee was elected Clerk and Treas. for 3 or 4 years. Since his home at Mt. Moriah, his membership and that of his wife and a part of his children have been with that church. Bro. Sallee was a firm believer in education and always took special pains to give to his children a good education, seven of them being our best teachers.

During President Cleveland's first administration, Bro. Sallee was Post Master at Mt. Moriah.

He was a man of good judgment, conservative in mind and firm in his convictions of what he deemed to be right, and, while he may not have soared so high as many in his religious experience, neither did he fall so low, and the trend of his daily life was onward and upward. He was a faithful husband, an affectionate parent, a good citizen and a living exemplar of the Christian religion.

Monday, February 22, 1897, we tried to comfort the bereft amidst their tears by the consolation of God's Word and the undying love of Christ Jesus, reading a part of John xi: and Rom. viii: 31 to 39, using the last two verses as a text. Some beautiful songs were sung and the remains laid to rest in the Mt. Moriah cemetery beside two dear children gone on before. The remains were followed to their last resting place by a large concourse of people, considering the almost impassible condition of the roads

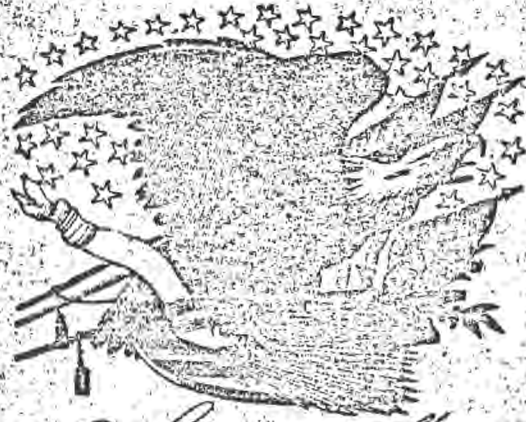

THOMAS EDWARD SALLEE, farmer and stockraiser was born in Mercer County, Missouri in 1841 (March 20), son of Joseph Maxey Salloo and Matilda Ann (Dunkerson) Salloo. The father was of French descent, born in Rockingham County, Virginia in 1815. Joseph's father Moses Salloo was a native of that state (Virginia), and a cooper by trade who died in Tennessee. When six years old Joseph Maxey Salloo went into Ringgold County, Tennessee, where he lived until his marriage in 1838. The following year he immigrated to northern Missouri, and located near Edenburg (now Grundy County) where he took up a claim. About a year later he sold out and came to Mercer County. There he settled upon a farm owned by Israel Smith, which is situated in Harrison Township. About two years later he moved to Lindley Township where he resided until 1876 at which time he moved to Mt. Moriah, Harrison County where he lived and served as Postmaster. He also held that position in Barr Oak, Mercer County, Missouri.

He was one of the oldest living settlers of northern Missouri, which when he came to it abounded in Indians and wild animals. It was a vast unbroken prairie. He was a democrat and for one year was assessor of half of Mercer County. His wife was born in Kentucky in 1813. She died in 1866 and was the mother of nine children of whom our subject, Thomas Edward is the second.

Thomas Edward received a common school education during his youth and made his home with his parents until of age. In 1861 he married Miss Elizabeth Woodward. Elizabeth (Woodward) Woodward was born in Decatur County, Indiana. The daughter of Elder John Woodward, she was born 1842 and died 1862.

In 1867 Thomas Edward Sallee married (2nd) Miss Adelia Putnam, daughter of Luther Quince and Lucy Ann Putnam, a native of Huron County, Ohio, born 5 October 1846. She came to Mercer County at 18 years of age and is the mother of the following children: Henrietta, Arthur C, Olive, Carrie Mae, Ethyl, Annie and Orville.

Mr. Sallee was a strong Union man during the war and in March 1862 enlisted in Company A, 3rd Missouri Cavalry for three years participating in the battles at Springfield and numerous severe skirmishes. In June 1864 he was discharged and enlisted in Company B, 13th Veteran Volunteer Cavalry and was afterward promoted to Company C of the same Regiment. In August 1865 he was 2nd Lieutenant, which position he held until discharge in May 1866 at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.

About 1857 he entered 100 acres of land in Section 3 Township 6S Range 26 where he located after his marriage and where he resided. He owned 200 acres of land and was one of Harrison Township's respected, enterprising farmers. He has always been a democrat and cast his first presidential vote for McClellan in 1864. In 1877 he was elected County Assessor and in 1879 re-elected to office thus serving four years. He received a majority of 200 for a Republican County of a 400 majority, which illustrates his popularity among the people. In 1875 he served as Township Assessor. He was a member of the Missionary Baptist Church 26 years. His wife was a member for 20 years.



Abraham Sallé was born at St. Martin, Ile de Re, Aunix, France, the son of Jean and Marie Sallé (Baird "Huguenot Emigration to America", I, 308). He was probably the most important member of the Huguenot colony at Manakintown. He was a merchant, was Clerk of King William Parish, a Captain of militia, and a Justice of Henrico Co., VA. (VM 2,5; 11, 294, 299; 12, 247; Va. Patent Bk. 10, 253). He first moved to New York, where he petitioned the Governor and Council for denization in 1700 (Baird I 308); and his two eldest sons by his wife, Olive Perault, were born there..... By Nov. 10, 1701, Abraham Sallé had moved to Manakintown as the list of French refugees on that date shows.....(he) died in Manakintown in 1720 and his will (in addition to bequests to his six children) leaves to his heirs all his interest in the estates of his late father, mother, brother, sister, father-in-law and uncle in France or England....¹

Boddie's account is a convenient source for the vital statistics for the second and third generations of the family which follow.

In many instances descendants of the other Sallees are known to having been living near descendants of Abraham. In such instances, differentiation becomes almost impossible.

FOREWORD

In 1964 this writer attempted to identify his immediate ancestors. He found genealogy intriguing and extended the scope of his research. Ten years later he had enough data for a book, The Pedigree of Henry Hardin Sallee, his maternal grandfather. Only a few copies of this book were made, but some of them became available to individuals who were interested in Sallee genealogy and wanted to buy a copy. Since none was available, the author photocopied the original and loaned it out. Almost every borrower sent in more information when he returned the copy. As the amount of such material increased it was decided to prepare a genealogy of the descendants of Abraham Sallé, emigrant ancestor of Henry Hardin Sallee. Such a genealogy was prepared and included in the appendix of an enlarged edition of the Pedigree which was published in 1978.

The 1978 genealogy contained some glaring gaps which the writer has been trying to fill. In addition to the results from this new research, data has continued to come in from other Sallee descendants with the result that there is enough new information to justify preparing a separate genealogy. However, this new, larger edition does not include hundreds of Sallee names which the writer has in his files. Besides the two limitations which restrict all research, lack of time and money; there are two problems which are particularly pertinent to research for information about the descendants of Abraham Sallé of Manakin Town in Virginia.

First: several courthouses have burned and the records they had contained were completely destroyed. Included were probate and marriage records which are major sources of genealogical data. Normally, census records can supplement courthouse records, but in this instance many census records are missing. As one result, the reader will find some individuals listed for whom the proof of
